- **NOTICE :**

Notice is hereby given that the Grand Prix 3 2010 Regatta will be sailed at the above venue. Entries are invited to participate in the regatta.

- **RULES :**

All races shall be sailed under the 2009/2012 ISAF The Racing Rules of Sailing, the SA.Sailing prescriptions and appendices thereto, and the relevant class rules, all subject to amendment by this Notice or the Sailing Instructions. **SPECIAL ATTENTION WILL BE GIVEN TO COMPLIANCE WITH SOUTH AFRICAN SAILING REQUIREMENTS WITH REGARD TO MEMBERSHIP OF SAS, CERTIFICATES OF FITNESS, AND CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY, where applicable.**

- **PROGRAMME :**

The first race will not start before 14h00 on Saturday, 27 March 2010. The times for subsequent races will be advertised on the official Regatta Notice Board at least half an hour before the race concerned. No race will start before 09h00 on Sunday, 28 March 2010. An "L" flag flown at the finish line will indicate that a back to back race will be sailed. An "L" flag flown ashore will indicate "see notice board".

- **MEASUREMENT**

Each yacht shall be in possession of a valid measurement or registration certificate.

- **SCORING SYSTEM :**

The LOW POINTS scoring system (appendix A of the racing rules) will apply. 6 races are scheduled. In the event of five or more races being sailed a discarded result will be allowed. A minimum of 4 races is required to constitute a regatta.

- **ENTRIES :**

A minimum of 5 entries will be required for a class to qualify as such. Classes not so qualified shall compete in the Open class, which shall also comply with the minimum entry requirements.

Entry fees :

R30-00 : Single handed boats.

R50-00 : Double handed boats.

Entries will be accepted no later than 45 minutes before the scheduled start of the first race. Entry forms shall be made out on the attached entry form and sent together with the required entry fee to : -

Entry fees will be refunded in the case of a boat prevented from competing in the series, provided that an application in writing for such refund is received by the K.W.T.Y.C. within 21 days after the last race of the GP3 Regatta.

- **GATE ENTRY, BOAT LEVY, ACCOMMODATION, AND CAMPING FEES:**

Plenty of camping and caravan sites are available.

Electricity is included in the fees for overnight visitors, who are not Stutterheim Aquatic Club members.

For all competitors and their non-competing family members, who are not Stutterheim Aquatic Club members, the standard club gate and camping fees and levies will be charged for the weekend. Please note that daily visitors will also be charged the standard club entry fees. Children under five years of age enter free.

DOGS : Please note that dogs are not welcome at the club or on the club grounds. Any person arriving with a dog will not be permitted to enter the club grounds and will be requested to place it with the SPCA in Stutterheim.
